FOREHEAD

"There are no wrinkles or lines," observes Dr. Goldenberg, which he ascribes to Botox (\$900-\$1.2K). "Botox can also explain why her brows are more raised," he adds.

CHEEKS

Dr. Mark points out that Cindy has "the golf ball look in the central cheek," which leads him to believe she filled with Sculptra for about \$2K. "I would have injected less," he says.

LIPS

Cindy's lips are plumper now than when she was younger, which doesn't happen naturally. "They're also a little uneven," Dr. Mark notes. He thinks she uses Juvéderm (\$1K per treatment).

JAWLINE

"Her jawline looks excellent," says Dr. Rivkin. "The skin tightening to achieve this can be done with Ultherapy." Cost: \$6K every two or three years.
